









## Egg Discussion Chicks

Cut around the perimeter and on the horizontal lines. Do not cut the vertical line. Fold each card in half on the vertical line. One side should show the chick picture and the other side should show the question. You can place each card in a plastic egg or all of the cards in one big plastic egg or basket.

	<p>Is it alright to cry when someone dies?</p>
	<p>What is a funeral? Have you ever been to a funeral?</p>
	<p>What is a memorial? Have you ever participated in a memorial?</p>

	<p>Why did Sarah mold the clay to spell Max?</p>
	<p>Why did Nathaniel design a memorial plaque?</p>
	<p>How did the other chicks help the children?</p>
	<p>What message did Leticia's picture send? How do you keep someone in your heart?</p>
